

We are thrilled to announce the HWCI Collections Committee and OCM curator James Vannurden have accepted a new artifact: an 1887 Estey Pump Organ donated by the Dondlinger Family. It was installed in the Hodge House

The house was built by African-American blacksmith Wesley Hodge between 1878 and 1885 and is a significant part of our community's heritage. In 1880, Wesley lived there with his wife Millie and their children, Fannie and James. The family was known for their musical talents, making the Estey Pump Organ a fitting addition to the exhibit.

In past years, the Hodge House was often mistaken as a parsonage due to its proximity to a church. However, research revealed its history with the Hodge family, and in 2011, Cowtown renamed the "Parsonage" to the "Hodge House" to authentically represent their story.
